

COMMUNICATIONS BRIEFING

1. ALL RADIOTELEPHONE PROCEDURE ARE TO BE FOLLOWED PER CAPR 100-1, VOLUME III.
2. SPEAK SLOWLY AND DISTINCTLY.
3. FOLLOW THE “REQUIRED REPORTING” PROCEDURES. A COPY SHOULD BE IN YOUR SORTIE FOLDER.
4. IF YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO MEET YOUR DESIGNATED TIME WITHIN FIVE (5) MINUTES, CALL MISSION BASE TO ESTABLISH A NEW TIME.
5. IF YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO REACH MISSION BASE, TRY GOING THROUGH THE HIGH BIRD, IF ONE IS IN OPERATION, OR TRY AND REACH ANOTHER CAP AIRCRAFT FOR RELAY.
6. IF ALL RADIO COMMUNICATIONS FAIL, LAND AT THE NEAREST AIRPORT AND CALL MISSION BASE AT 623-582-6626 OR 623-582-6627. TOLL FREE NUMBER IS 1-888-400-6626.
7. FM REPEATERS IN USE ARE:

 CHANNEL 7 – TOWERS
 CHANNEL 8 – MT ORD
 CHANNEL 9 – MT LEMMON
 CHANNEL 11 – WHITE TANKS
8. WHEN REPORTING TIME OFF AND TIME DOWN, USE SIMPLEX, TAC 1
9. IF YOU NEED TO COMMUNICATE ON VHF, USE 122.9.
10. USE PROPER PROWORDS. DO NOT USE “GO AHEAD”.
11. COMMUNICATIONS IS ANOTHER TOOL TO PROMOTE SAFETY. USE IT WISELY.
