### ADVANCED RADIO OPERATORS COURSE:

Training and testing to be issued the CAP ROA card which is a prerequisite form many Ground and Air ES functions.  
 Schedule 0800-1200 Fee: Seniors/Cadets \$15.00 includes meals. See Registration form for combined course fees.

### FIRST AID:

Training in Basic First Aid by a certified instructor. Students who complete the course will be issued a First Aid card which is a prerequisite for many Ground and Air ES functions.  
 Schedule 12:00-1700 Fee: \$50.00 Seniors...Reduced price for Cadets \$40.00 includes meals and course material.

### SCANNER AND OBSERVER GROUND SCHOOL:

Students will complete all the ground training prerequisites necessary before beginning flight training for Scanners and Observers. This is also excellent review material for any existing Mission Pilot or pilot interested in becoming a Mission Pilot.

- 6) Flight Line Marshaling...Students will complete all the prerequisites to become a Flight Line Marshaler.
